RE: Debrief on select ISDII "Hammer" non-flight crew

Sir,

In a response to an order to perform routine periodic internal threat assessment, the following is the first group of short personnel summaries for randomly selected non-flight crew members assigned to the ISDII "Hammer".

Note that as a result of this activity one immediate threat has been identified, though several personnel may benefit from additional motivational and educational activities to boost their morale and efficiency. In detail:

- Low threat: 2 Corporal 3rd Vynn Ordos; Sub-Lieutenant Mirax Brice
- Medium threat: 1 Lieutenant Kyla Typhe
- Medium-high threat: Corporal 1st Devshak Redloc
- High threat: Shoan Vondar (CMDR/MAJ Genie's Personal Chef)

Further assessment activities will continue as requested. Similar reports will be prepared for each 5-person group according to schedule.





Subject I: Vynn Ordos

Rank: Corporal, 3rd.

Position: Mechanic, Alpha Squadron Flight 2 (Missile Boat).

Race: Human.

Gender: Male.

Age: 37 standard years.

Origin: Balmorra.

Education: Imperial Technical Academy on Commenor, graduate score 87/100.

Marital status: Married; 3 children.

Material status: Sufficient wealth for upkeeping closest family.

Family background: Imperial loyalist parents, average wealth, no known defectors in closest circle. Siblings attended various Imperial schools and are still in active service around the Empire.

Motivation for joining the Corps: Primary: Personal feeling of duty to protect his homeland and re-establish order and Imperial rule in the galaxy. Secondary: Employment stability and benefits.

Incident record: 10 bar fights (4 initiated), 7 late for shift, 1 working under influence (spice)

Key strengths: Extremely skilled with welding and other mechanical repair equipment: capable of quick repair of nearly any hull damage to ships. Good knowledge of mechanics of Missile Boats (primary position responsibility) and TIE craft. Positive attitude towards his responsibilities.

Known weaknesses: Not efficient working in team: prefers solitude. Limited understanding of electronics and power systems. Easily distracted by attractive humanoid females.

Risks and threats: Susceptible to seduction.

Suggested actions: Monitor social relationships with any and all humanoid females under investigation for potential espionage. Work on understanding his role as part of the team supporting Alpha Squadron. Increase motivation/incentives to pass his knowledge on to co-workers.

Summary:

Corporal Ordos does not stand out from the crowd, neither physically (average height and body composition) or due to any activity. His preference for solitude results in few relationships established with his closest co-workers and/or Alpha Squadron pilots.

Ordos is valued by his co-workers for his particular skillset in mechanical repair, which enables Alpha's craft to return to active duty an estimated 30% quicker over average replacement (OAR).

His susceptibility to humanoid females can potentially be leveraged by enemy spies (both in terms of active information acquisition and potential blackmail), but can also serve as blackmail opportunity if Corporal needs to be "incentivized" to certain actions.

Threat level: LOW







Subject II: Mirax Brice

Rank: Sub-Lieutenant

Position: Mechanic, Beta Squadron Flight 1 (TIE Defender)

Race: Human

Gender: Female

Age: 28 standard years

Origin: Chazwa

Education: No formal higher education; self-taught mechanic.

Marital status: Single.

Material status: Wealthy for her species, age and social situation.

Family background: Daughter of a chief ship mechanic working in the Chazwa Dockyards, lost mother when SL was 3 years old. No known siblings. Father still employed at ChD, above-average record and known Imperial supporter.

Motivation for joining the Corps: Ability to work on the finest starfighters (and technology) in the galaxy.

Incident record: None.

Key strengths: Excellent overall mechanical skills.

Known weaknesses: Naive. Has tendency to blindly trust others.

Risks and threats: Gullible, susceptible to exploitation by enemy agents.

Suggested actions: SL Brice's direct CO to monitor her activities for any signs of exploitation by enemy agents.

Summary:

SL Brice was raised in a model community (below-average: poverty, crime, etc.; above-average: income, education, etc.) by a hard-working chief ship mechanic who wished his only daughter mastered his own craft. This shows in multiple expected ways: SL is easy to manipulate and mislead, has oversimplified and glorified image of the galaxy, but at the same time her technical skill is unmatched within Beta's crew.

Her gullibility can potentially be exploited by enemy agents. However, her loyalty to the Empire remains unshaken and her perfect service record (including periodic threat assessments and notes from ISB trainers on her attendance in trainings on counterespionage) suggests she will report any activity she deems as suspicious to her superiors.

SL's technical skill deems her an excellent candidate for a future lead mechanic for a fighter squadron, but her loyalty and dedication should be tested prior to any promotions.

Threat level: LOW.





Subject III: Devshak Redloc

Rank: Corporal, 1st.

Position: Supply Officer, Epsilon Squadron Flight 3 (Missile Boat)

Race: Devaronian

Gender: Male

Age: 63 standard years

Origin: Records inconsistent (crypto department detected no sign of forgery, suspected corruption of data through database damage during the rebel insurrection).

Education: No formal higher education.

Marital status: Single.

Material status: Average for his race, age and social situation.

Family background: Records inconsistent (crypto department detected no sign of forgery, suspected corruption of data through database damage during the rebel insurrection).

Motivation for joining the Corps: Employment stability, benefits.

Incident record: 46 bar fights (0 started; always provoked by other party)

Key strengths: Above-average physical strength, even for his species. Above-average intelligence for his species (exceeding (!) average human intelligence).

Known weaknesses: Gambling - occasionally.

Risks and threats: None (that we can identify at this point).

Suggested actions: ISB has not been able to identify any immediate threats outside of gambling (potential addiction, gambling dues, etc.). However, limited available reliable records and a combination of personal traits (intelligent, solitary alien) suggest Corporal Redloc should be under constant supervision and monitoring.

Summary:

Relatively quiet, do-his-job-but-not-much-more kind. Nearly ideally average in job efficiency (1.35% OAR). Takes part in most social activities by his co-workers, but rarely takes the lead in anything.

His incident record, although suspicious, is valid: witnesses of all incidents said that it was another party who started the incident (most often: "to check rumours on Devaronians being so strong").

While his co-workers and Epsilon Squadron pilots have not noted anything suspicious about Corporal Redloc, as a non-human with very limited confirmed records in databases, Corporal should be monitored for potential subversive activity. Devaronians have a confirmed history of difficulty in following orders and maintaining discipline. This one seems almost too perfect to be real.

Threat level: MEDIUM-HIGH.





Subject IV: Shoan Vondar

Rank: Chef

Position: Personal Cook to CMDR/MAJ Genie, Lambda Squadron Flight 1 (TIE Advanced)

Race: Human

Gender: Male

Age: 44 standard years

Origin: Yag'Dhul

Education: Yag'Gdul Planetary Culinary Academy – graduated with honours

Marital status: Single, 5 children.

Material status: Difficult to confirm. Officially – no wealth. Unofficially – leading a life of a celebrity, spending significant amounts of money (acquired from where? Unclear!) on a whim.

Family background: Parents are sports celebrities on Yag'Dhul. Vondar is only legal child (though both parents have multiple extramarital children).

Motivation for joining the Corps: Not officially enlisted. Hired directly by CMDR/MAJ Genie.

Incident record: During current employment: none. Previously: multiple DUI, illegal spice possession, sexual harassment and other charges, but no convictions.

Key strengths: Excellent cook/chef (had opportunity to verify during a dinner with CMDR/MAJ Genie). Extremely easily establishes relationships (though he focuses on humanoid females, but not exclusively).

Known weaknesses: Extravagant lifestyle. Huge spending habits. Tendency

Risks and threats: No proven loyalty to the Empire. Unchecked access to CMRD/MAJ Genie.

Suggested actions: Run full background and loyalty check. Constantly monitor all communications and activities.

Summary:

This celebrity cook from Yag'Dhul may be a master in his arts, but as any such artist is keen to flashiness and extravagant lifestyle. If aforementioned would be threatened, there is no assurance of his loyalty to the Fleet and/or Empire.

Obviously, Vondar is a celebrity and does everything he can to maintain and exploit this status. Vondar is the "star" of every social gathering of Lambda (and others; he never misses an opportunity to "shine," even in front of senior staff), often using this unofficial "status" for personal gain.

Inquiry: Who allowed CMDR/MAJ Genie to hire him? Who pays his wage (which is assumably horrendous)? If proven an Imperial loyalist, potential to utilize as an agent?

Threat level: HIGH.





Subject V: Kyla Typhe

Rank: Lieutenant

Position: Requisition Officer, ISDII Hammer

Race: Twi-Lek

Gender: Female

Age: 32 standard years

Origin: Nal-Hutta

Education: No record available.

Marital status: Single.

Material status: Wealthy for her species.

Family background: Parents were slaves to various Hutt families on Nal-Hutta; assumed dead for over 30 years, but no records exist to confirm – Hutts do not care for creating records for slaves. At least 5 known siblings, but no known established relationship with Lieutenant Typhe (likely siblings were sold to various Hutt families).

Motivation for joining the Corps: Despises Hutts, slavery and any form of chaos (thus despises the rebels as well). Wants to establish Imperial order as wide across the galaxy as possible because she sees it as a way to destroy what she hates.

Incident record: 3 inappropriate relationship with fellow crew members

Key strengths: Above-average memory, analytical skills. Methodical, practical. According to other crew members – extremely attractive.

Known weaknesses: Former addiction to spice. Tendency to use various addictive and psychoactive substances. Lack of technical and/or mechanical knowledge, as well as limited combat skills deem her unfit for any combat position.

Risks and threats: Medium likelihood of return to active spice addiction. Low-to-medium likelihood of rogue actions if faced with choice between Imperial duty and revenge on Hutts, slavers, etc.

Suggested actions: Constantly monitor psychoactive substance intake and blood levels. In case of EH's collaborative dealings with any criminal group it is advised to increase monitoring measures on Lieutenant Typhe to ensure her loyalty stays on the correct side.

Summary:

Lieutenant Typhe is difficult to decipher. On one hand, she is a very attractive and social person, easily establishing relationships with various crew members and performing her duties above average. On the other she is often knowingly taking advantage of naive fresh officers to acquire benefits ranging from personal gifts (likes expensive minerals), through priority seating at cultural venues.

Lack of reliable records from her home planet and her susceptibility to potential rogue actions introduce further uncertainty into the assessment of Lieutenant. While she is over-performing at her position and is valuable to the Fleet, her flaws may potentially deem her expendable for the greater benefit of the Corps.

Threat level: MEDIUM.
