MISSION OBJECTIVE

Destruction of a Rebel outpost within half a light year of Emperor's Hammer territory.

MISSION PARAMETERS

At 09.00 local time, Bravo and Delta Squads will be dropped planetside approximately 25 clicks from the target. Bravo on the North side, Delta on the South side. Both Squads need to be in place at the designated time. At 05.00 they are to commence the assault.

BRAVO SQUAD

Will be in charge of distracting the Rebel troops. They will launch the attack with whatever weapons they can get and draw the enemy troops away from the base. Retreat is required to draw troops further away.

MISSION REPORT

At 05.00 heavy ordnance was launched at the Rebel base. Snipers were deployed to take out the guards. Enemy Walkers and ground forces were dispatched after the first explosions. We were able to take out a good number of enemy ground forces as the exited the base. At this point we were too far away to effectively deal with the enemy Walkers. As ordered, we retreated into the forest when ground troops closed in on our position. Once in the forest we were able to ambush the enemy and take out three of the Walkers. At this point the enemy retreated back to their base. We followed to delay them as much as possible.

CASUALTIES

Confirmed destruction of three enemy Walkers with the standard complement of two crewmembers, as well as fifteen enemy soldiers taken out by sniper fire. There are twenty two unconfirmed kills.

Five Imperial troopers were killed.

MISSION EVALUATION

Intel report the Rebel facility was damaged but not destroyed. The charges were set in the wrong locations, resulting in the key positions not being destroyed. It is expected this facility will be back up and running within two weeks.

PLATOON COMMANDER RECOMMENDATIONS

Delta Squad was responsible for placing the charges. At this they have failed. They lay blame for this with inaccurate maps of the facility. MISSION EVALUATION

Delta Squad of Platoon B17 was assigned the task of destroying a Rebel facility on planet GX-751-E at which they failed. Although damaged, the facility was not destroyed and will be up and running soon. The Rebels are now alerted to our knowledge of the existence of the facility so its destruction will be problematic.

COMPANY COMMANDER RECOMMENDATION

Members of Delta squad are to be terminated for their failure. Preferably this should be done in public to remind other troopers of the price of failure.

The enemy facility needs to be destroyed as quickly as possible before the enemy can supply the facility with reinforcements. As they are aware of our presence, a ground assault is unlikely to succeed at this point. Recommend deferring this assignment to the TIE Corps for an orbital assault on the facility.
